2. Participants: all riders, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA
3. Judging procedure: observational judging procedure in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA

**WB 2: Mounted Games, U18**

1. Four-year-old and older ponies/horses are eligible.
2. Participants: all riders under 18, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA
3. Judging procedure: observational judging procedure in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA

**WB 3: Mounted Games, U15**

1. Four-year-old and older ponies/horses are eligible.
2. Participants: all riders under 15 years of age, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA.
3. Judging procedure: observational judging procedure in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA

**WB 4: Mounted Games, U12**

1. Four-year-old and older ponies/horses are eligible.
2. Participants: all riders under 12 years of age, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA.
3. Judging procedure: observational judging procedure in accordance with the rules and regulations of the IMGA

Special provisions:

- Every participating rider must have valid personal accident insurance and liability insurance. Liability insurance is mandatory for both horse and rider! The organiser accepts no liability for damage!
- The insurance obligation (liability) also covers ponies/horses led or ridden by the rider.
- The organiser accepts no liability for damage caused to participants, their ponies/horses, equipment or third parties.
- The respective owner bears sole responsibility for the care of the ponies/horses (stable tent/paddock).
- Participants of legal age must register independently. If a minor wishes to participate in one of the competitions, registration must be carried out by a parent or guardian.
- By submitting the entry, all conditions of the competition are accepted unconditionally. Should any of the listed points be invalid, the remainder of the competition shall remain valid.
- Minors must be accompanied by their legal guardians.
- Parents are responsible for their children.
- If the organiser provides paddock areas, the owner/rider is responsible for setting up the paddock properly and safely. A power supply must be connected. The owner/rider must ensure that the area is safe to use.

The organiser is not liable for any damage caused!

- All dogs must be kept on a leash.
- Fencing is only carried out in the stables or on the paddock.
- Horse/pony riding is only permitted with equipment that is suitable for competition and complies with IMGA rules. This includes, but is not limited to, a saddle, bridle and helmet.
- Readiness to start must be declared by 27 July 2026. We reserve the right to change this date.
- Tents are not permitted in the paddock areas!

## Refunds and cancellations

- The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event in the event of a lack of economic viability. Entry fees already paid will be refunded minus fixed costs (including, among other things, the rental of the event space). The absolute amount depends on the number of entries received.
- If the event has to be cancelled due to official orders, entry fees already paid will be refunded minus fixed costs (including, among other things, the rental of the event space). Official orders include events for which the organiser is not responsible, such as (but not limited to) severe weather, fire or pandemics. The absolute amount depends on the number of entries received.
- If a rider is unable to participate in the competition for medical reasons – relating to either the rider or the horse – 60% of the entry fee will be refunded for early entries (1) and 40% for regular/late entries (2/3) if cancellation is made by 31 May 2026 and a valid medical certificate is provided. The organiser reserves the right to increase the refund depending on the situation; the decision on this is at the discretion of the organiser. However, there is no entitlement to an increased refund. The medical certificate must contain the following wording: 'The rider/horse is unable to participate in sporting competitions due to illness or injury.'
- If a rider participates in the Mounted Games European Team Championships 2026 and is therefore unable to participate in the World Individual Championships, the entry fee will be refunded minus any transfer fees. The organiser must be informed of this in writing by 31 May 2026 at the latest. If notification is not received by the deadline, there will be no entitlement to a refund. If the date of the European Team Championships is postponed, this entitlement will also lapse.
- Participants are entitled to transfer their starting place to another person. A fee of €50 will be charged for this. Transfers between age groups are possible until the closing date for entries. After that, transfers are only possible after consultation with the organiser.

Vaccination and health regulations:

**Vaccinations**

- All ponies/horses must have a valid influenza vaccination in accordance with FEI regulations. The guidelines can be found at <https://inside.fei.org/>. The vaccination regulations are a prerequisite for entering the event grounds.

**Health check**

- From 24 July 2026 onwards, the body temperature of the pony/horse must be measured and documented daily. The obligation to check body temperature ends when the premises are finally left. The temperature log must be presented on request.

**Equipment and bridle:**

- All equipment required for riding, such as saddles and bridles, must be in perfect condition so that it can withstand the stresses of competition.
- The equipment must comply with IMGA rules.

**Arrival:**

- Valid papers (Traces) must be carried for the transport of horses that are not kept in Germany and presented on request.

**Anti-Doping:**

Riders are subject to the regulations of the WADA – World Anti-Doping Agency.

Horses are subject to the regulations of the FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations (EADCMR).

All substances on the respective valid lists are prohibited.

**Doping controls**

The organiser, IMGA officials or authorised veterinarians may carry out the following checks at any time without prior notice:

**For riders:**

- Urine or blood samples
- Alcohol and breath tests (in accordance with IMGA regulations)

**For ponies/horses:**

- Blood samples
- Urine samples
- Hair/sweat/saliva samples
- Clinical examinations
- Medication checks in the stable area

By registering, the participant expressly agrees to this.

**Consequences of violations**

In the event of a positive test:

- Immediate exclusion of rider and pony/horse from the competition
- Disqualification of all previous results
- Immediate departure from the event grounds
- Report to IMGA and national associations
- All costs of the investigation to be borne by the rider
- Possible further suspensions and sanctions by IMGA

Ponies/horses must be **free of doping or medication-related substances**.

Ponies/horses with medication residues without an approved exemption will be excluded.

**Illnesses and exclusion:**

- Horses that are not in perfect health or whose health status is unclear will be excluded from participation.
- In the event of notifiable diseases (e.g. strangles, EHV1 outbreak), the emergency protocol will come into effect immediately. Affected horses and riders will be isolated. The costs are to be borne by the rider.
